■ Natural Resources Management Minor

A minor should be declared

at the time a student accumulates 90 credit hours. A minimum overall CPHR for courses comprising the minor is 2.00.

A student may double count courses between the minor and GEC requirements only. Courses taken on a Pass/Non-Pass basis may not be applied to the minor.

When a student completes the minor following these guidelines he or she need only file the form, available from the SENR office, with an Arts and Sciences Counselor. Any variation from the program described on this sheet needs the approval of the Academic Administrative Officer/School Secretary.

The minor in natural resources is designed to introduce students to basic natural resources/environmental management concepts, techniques and practices, and should be especially interesting to students intending to be citizen participants in environmental activities. A total of 27 hours is required for this minor
