Abstract: The mission of the Lake Erie Islands Nature and Wildlife Center (LEINWC), located on South Bass Island in the Western Basin of Lake Erie, is to promote conservation of and education about the flora, fauna, and lands of the Lake Erie Islands ecosystems. Historically, the LEINWC was the site of a private museum collection of North American fish and wildlife but now is a board-directed non-profit educational center. We have a long-standing tradition of educating South Bass Island visitors and residents. Our Youth Nature Camp programs and weekly themed outreach events are perennial favorites on the Islands. Recognizing that our greatest support comes from Island residents that have a strong sense of stewardship of the Islands, we are building a citizen science program that exposes the science of conservation to those that depend on it the most.
