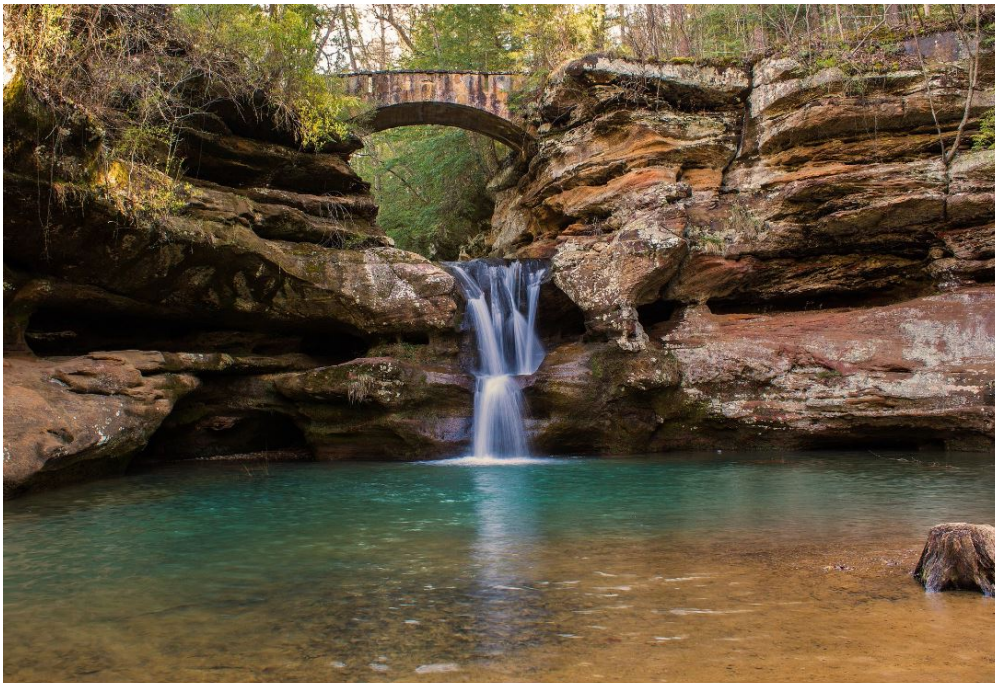

Earlier, Easier, and More Accurate: the NEW FAFSA

Beginning with the 2017-18 academic year, the [Free Application for Federal Student Aid \(FAFSA\)](#) will be **available October 1**. Students and families will use income tax information from two years prior to complete the application. These significant changes, [announced last year](#) by the Department of Education will make the FAFSA process earlier, easier and more accurate. Enrollment Appointments Have Been Set

Every semester, the University Registrar assigns enrollment appointments (scheduling windows) for all undergraduate students. These appointments tell you the specific time at which you may begin enrolling in courses for the next term. The Registrar just finished assigning these appointments, and has begun emailing students with appointment details. Remember, you can access the details of your scheduling window at **anytime** through your [Student Center](#) (go to the "Enrollment Information" box on the right).

Make sure you know exactly when your enrollment appointment opens, so that you can begin scheduling for Spring ASAP!

The LEED Green Associate (GA) credential is the only entry level sustainability designation and shows employers and clients that you have certified knowledge in the green building industry. This course meets the LEED GA exam's eligibility requirements and the USGBC charges a \$100 (reduced for students) fee for the actual exam which can be taken at any time at your nearest Prometric center.
