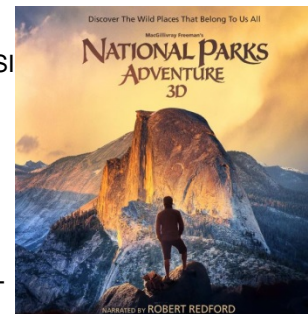

Just as buildings can be LEED certified, people in the sustainable construction industry can become LEED Professionals. The LEED Green Associate (GA) credential is the only entry level sustainability designation and

shows employers and clients that you have certified knowledge in the green building industry. This course meets the LEED GA exam's eligibility requirements and the USGBC charges a \$100 (reduced for students) fee for the actual exam which can be taken at any time at your nearest Prometric center.
