1. Check your graduation audit letter.

You should have received an email from Renee Johnston recently with important commencement information. Please read the email thoroughly.

3. Check the web:

4. Do you have your tickets ordered?

To accommodate the increasing number of guests who wish to attend Ohio State's Autumn Commencement in the Schottenstein Center, we have instituted a ticketing process. Admission **tickets are free** but must be ordered online through the "My Ohio State Student Account" portal used to request athletic and other tickets. As an autumn semester graduate, you are guaranteed to receive four general admission tickets with the option of joining a waitlist for up to four additional tickets. A ticket is required for all guests age 2 and older. Graduates do not require a ticket. The ticket request **deadline closes on December 1 (at 11:59pm)**. New Campus Sustainability Podcast: Between the Green

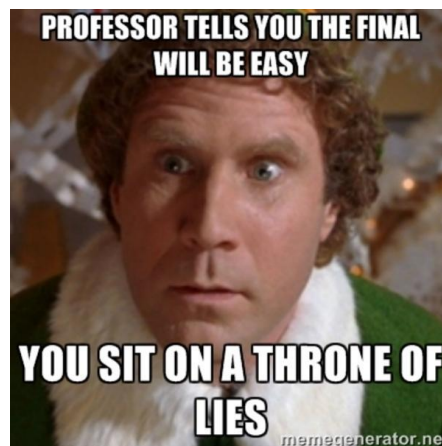
