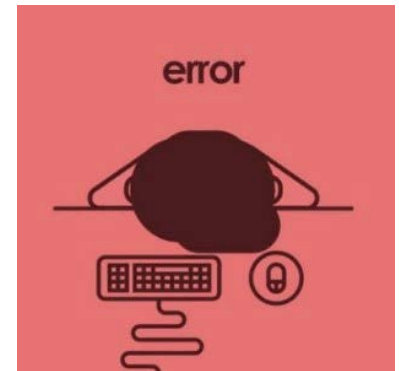

New EEDS Elective options for Sustainability in Business Specialization

We are pleased to offer a **new specialization elective option for EEDS students in the sustainability in business specialization**, beginning spring semester 2019. Just as a reminder, these are 1.5 credits per class below, so in order to satisfy your 3 credit hour specialization elective requirement for the sustainability in business specialization you will need to take both BUSML 3381 and BUSML 4385 (session 1 & session 2).

A few important notes regarding registration:

1. You should not register for BUSML 4385 during session 1 as you will need to take BUSML 3381 first. Register for one of the two sections of BUSML 4385 during session 2 only.
2. BUSML 3381 requires junior standing and enrollment in the EEDS program and BUSML 4385 requires previous completion of BUS ML 3381, enrollment in EEDS, and junior standing.
3. Just a reminder that these courses currently only satisfy the specialization elective requirement for EEDS students in the sustainability in business specialization.
