Great Lakes AIS Landing Blitz

- Collaborative outreach campaign to raise awareness about preventing the spread of aquatic invasive species through recreational boating and related activities
- Local volunteers partner with state agencies to deliver consistent messaging about preventing the introduction and spread of AIS from the movement of watercraft and equipment between water bodies at both public and private boating access sites throughout the state
- Effort occurs during a set timeframe
- Event is promoted locally and statewide.









Messaging

- Local partners are empowered to meet with boaters to deliver outreach that may include:
 - "Clean, Drain, Dry" and "Stop Aquatic Hitchhikers" campaign messaging
 - Boat washing, inspection, and equipment decontamination procedures (with and without a mobile or permanent wash station)
 - Reporting protocols for priority invasive species and others
 - State specific AIS laws and regulations



Before leaving and before launching... inspect everything!









Expected Outcomes

- Boaters/anglers that are better informed about AIS prevention and best management practices that can be used to limit the spread of AIS
- Increased media attention (press releases, radio spots, etc.) on AIS at both a local and regional scale
- Strengthened local, state, and regional partnerships on AIS outreach

Tournament Equipment to Check

- Tubs
- Hoses
- Pumps
- Scale
- Bump tank
- Measuring board
- Totes
- Bags
- Nets
- Docks
- Judge/release boat









Angler Equipment to Check

- Boat
 - Anchor systems
 - Water in bilge, motor, live wells etc.
- Trailer
 - Rollers/Bunks, Axles, Lights/Wires














OHIO SEA GRANT AND STONE LABORATORY

BMP – Good

- Inspect boats, trailers and all equipment
- Remove any vegetation, debris or animals
- Drain water from Motor, Bilge, Wells, etc.
- Plan and record your efforts













OHIO SEA GRANT AND STONE LABORATORY

BMP – Better

- Inspect Remove Drain
- Cold Rinse boats, trailers and equipment with garden hose
- Disinfect with a mild bleach (0.5 oz/quart water) or salt solution (2/3 cup/gallon water) on all
 - equipment









BMP-Best

- Inspect Remove Drain Decontaminate
- High Pressure Rinse with a pressure washer in a wash line for boats/trailer









BMP – Exceptional

- Inspect Remove Drain Decontaminate
- Hot Pressure Rinse with pressure washer with water above 140° F in a wash line for boats/trailers.
