Columbus State Community College's Environmental Science, Safety & Health Program offers the

OSHA Health & Safety Training for Hazardous Waste Workers (40-Hr HAZWOPER)



The summer semester course is blended, with lecture and some activities online, and the OSHA-required hands-on activities and final exam taking place on campus during June

OSHA requires this certification for employees working at contaminated sites and is a nice resume builder. This 2-credit class (ESSH 2520) is being offered Summer Semester 2022 in a blended format – lecture and some activities are through distance learning (online portion begins on May 30, with Blackboard access on May 26), with the required hands-on training taking place during scheduled times from Wednesday, June 22, through Friday, June 24, 2022. The course is \$335.86 (in-state tuition and instructional fees) with an additional \$100 lab fee. Matriculation and additional fees may apply. Undergraduate students attending other colleges in central Ohio may be able to take this class tuition-free through the Higher Education Council of Columbus. The HECC registration period is May 16–27 (see your academic advisor for more details.)
