End of Fall Semester, 2 nd year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Submit faculty advisor name to Renee Johnston using the Faculty Advisor Form (see senr.osu.edu/forms).
Throughout 2 nd year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Work with your faculty advisor to build your personalized honors plan. • Brainstorm potential research topic.
End of Spring Semester 2 nd year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Submit honors plan to Renee Johnston in 210 Kottman Hall.
Fall Semester 3 rd year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Enroll in ENR 4890H to develop research proposal.
